Parenting is a faith journey as you pass on the faith to your children. Make sure you have a road map and destination in mind.


▶ Deuteronomy 6: 4-9

 - Philippians 2:3-4 Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others.

- Connect intentionally with others in community.
 - Colossians 2:2 My goal is that they may be encouraged in heart and united in love, so that they may have the full riches of complete understanding, in order that they may know the mystery of God, namely, Christ.

- ► Give generously to God who gave you everything.
 - ▶ 2 Corinthians 9:6-8

Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work.


- Share willingly about the hope you have in Jesus Christ.
