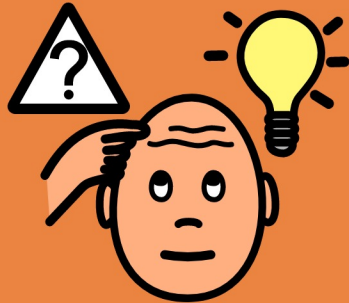

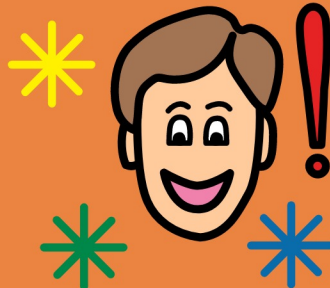

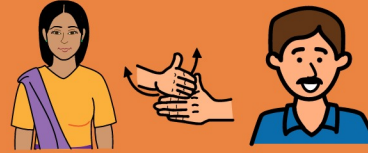

This is the true story



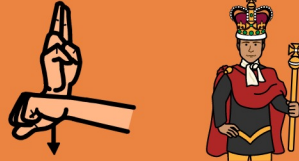
of how Lydia shared what she had with Paul

used to be Saul?



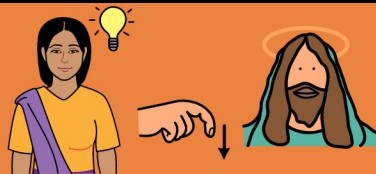
He was the man who hurt a lot of people, but

no one to tell her about Jesus.

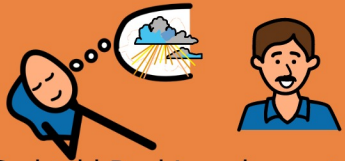


Lydia asked God to show her more about Himself.

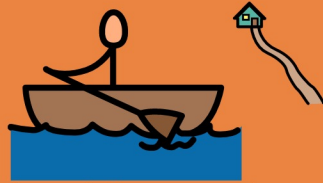


One day Lydia was praying by the river with friends who wanted to know God, too.

God told Paul in a dream to go to that same faraway place, Macedonia.



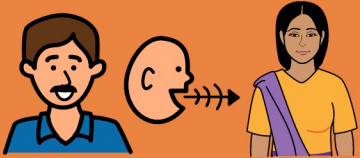
Paul would have to take a boat to get there.



When Paul and his helper got to Macedonia, they walked right to the place



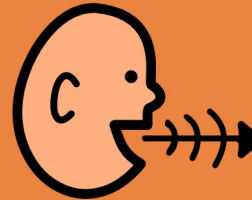
where Lydia was praying to learn more about God!



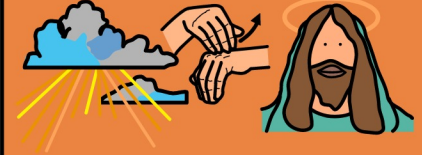
Paul was very happy to tell Lydia and her friends



that God had sent him.



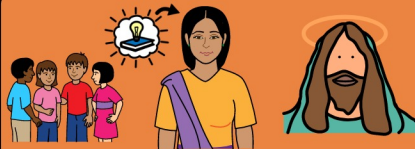
He told them that

They asked Jesus to take away (rescue them from)



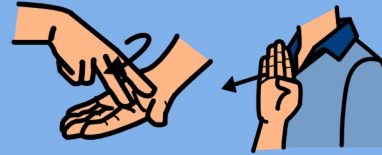
their sinful hearts.

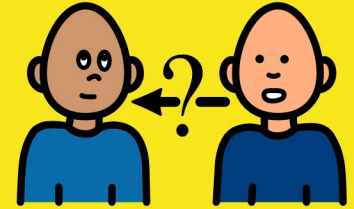
1. The kid next door calls me names and says I talk funny. I will:



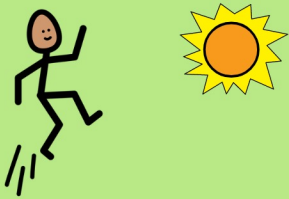
Remember that God made me in His image to be like Him.

2. I have lots of energy on Saturday mornings. I can:



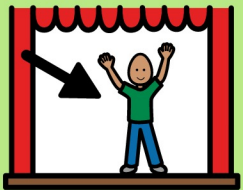
Ride my bike.
