1. You see papers on the classroom floor.



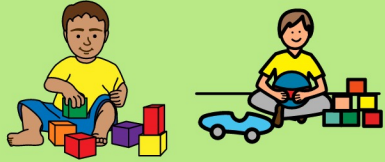
You kick them around the floor.

You pick up the papers and put them on the table.



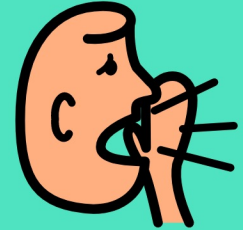
2. Mom says you need to let your little brother play with you and your friend.



You let him play but are not kind to him.



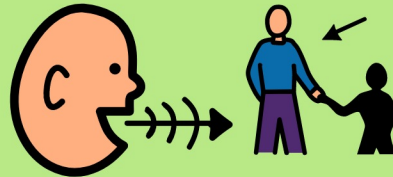
You smile and show your brother what you're playing.



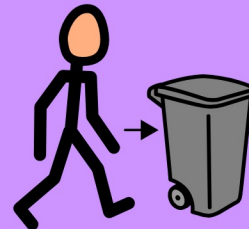
You tell mom, "That's not fair!"
