what he was going to do.



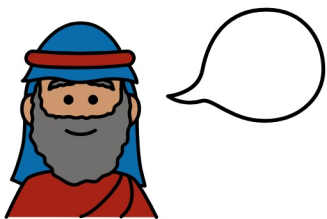
Philip answered

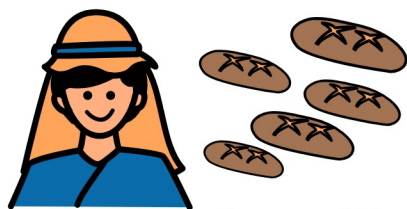
"Suppose we were

to have just a bite.



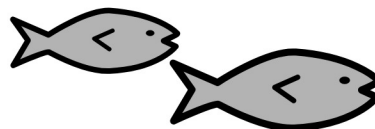
That would take

barley bread.



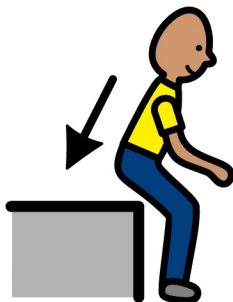

fish.



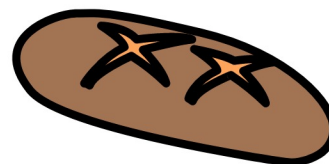
But how far will that

sit down, then He



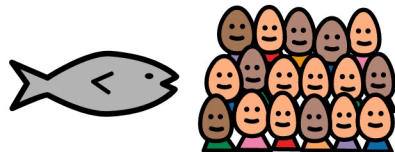
took the bread



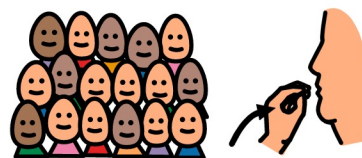
and gave thanks.



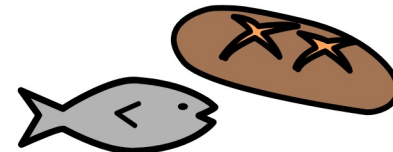

with the fish.



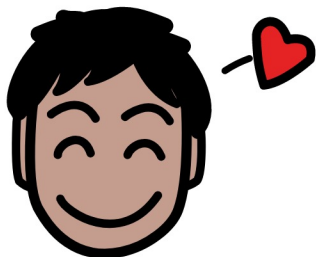

fish as they wanted



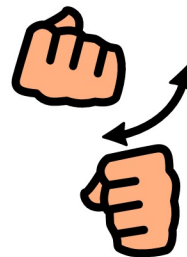
