Mary, Martha and Lazarus in Judea,



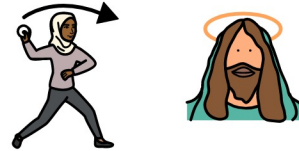
near Jerusalem.



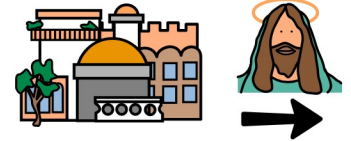
Jesus taught in Jerusalem.



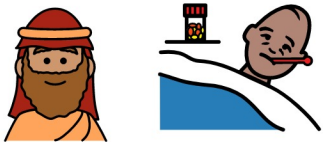
When Jesus told people that He was God,



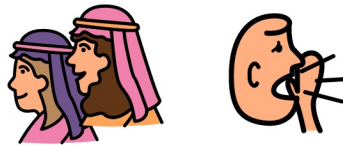
they threatened to kill Him with stones because they didn't believe Him.



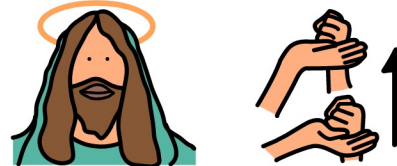
Jesus and His disciples left.



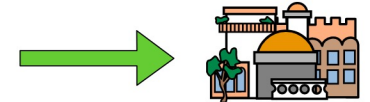
While He was gone, Lazarus got sick.

After 2 days, Jesus told His disciples, "Let us go back to Judea."



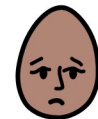
The disciples didn't want to go because people had threatened to kill Jesus.



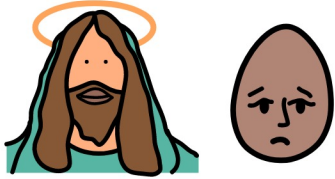
Jesus told them, "Lazarus is dead. For your benefit, I am glad I was not there.



Now you will believe. But let us go to him."



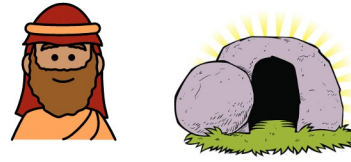
When Jesus arrived, He saw that everyone was sad.



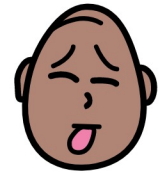
Jesus was also very sad.



Jesus told them to move the stone where Lazarus was buried.



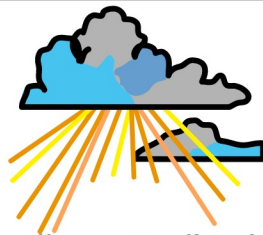
Lazarus had been in the tomb for 4 days,



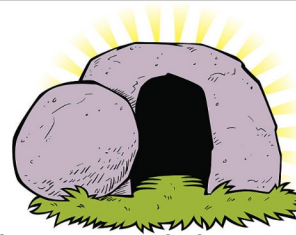
so Martha told Him there would be a bad smell.



Jesus said, "Didn't I tell you that if you believe,



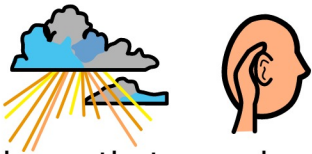
you will see God's glory?"

Jesus said to God, "Father, I thank you for hearing me.



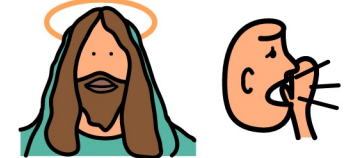
I know that you always hear me.



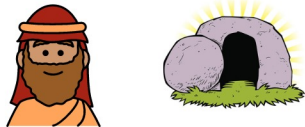
But I said this for the benefit of the people standing here.



I said it so they will believe that you sent me."



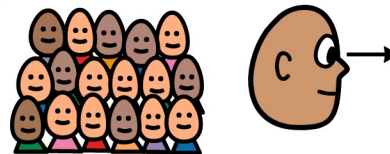
Then Jesus called out in a loud voice,

Jesus told them to take off the strips of cloth he was buried in and let him go.



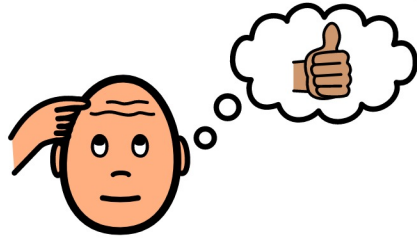
Many people saw this
