For 30 pieces of silver,



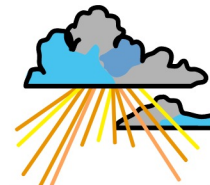
Judas gave

Jesus knew this would happen because it was



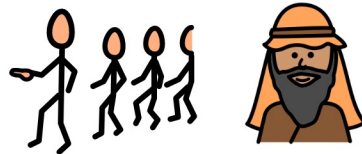
what God wanted (it was God's will).

religious leaders to Jesus.



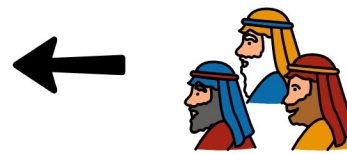
Peter tried to protect Jesus with his sword, but Jesus stopped him.



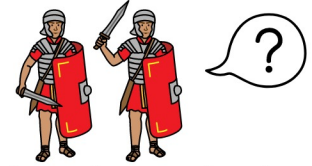
He knew this was God's will.



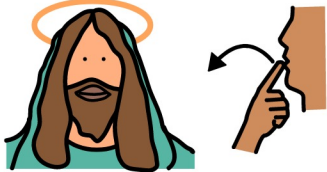
The religious leaders took Jesus to trial.



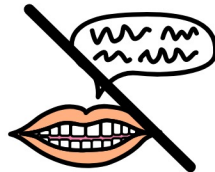
Jesus' friends and followers left Him.

and Jesus told the truth.



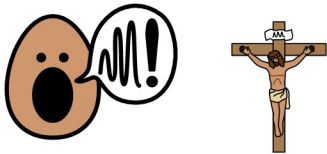
The religious leaders thought Jesus was lying.



They couldn't do anything, so they took Jesus to the Roman governor, Pilate.



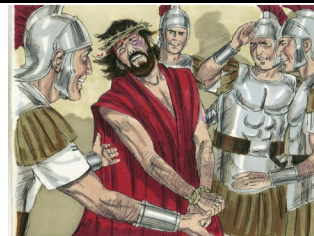
Pilate didn't see that Jesus did anything wrong,

Pilate was afraid the people would get him in trouble with his boss, so he gave in.



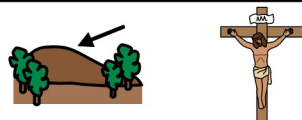
Jesus was beaten and a



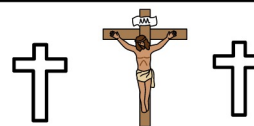
crown of thorns was placed on His head.



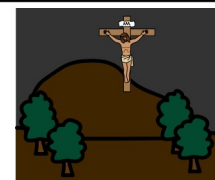
Jesus had to carry a heavy wooden beam that they would use to crucify Him.

Jesus cried out, "My God, My God. Why have you deserted me?"



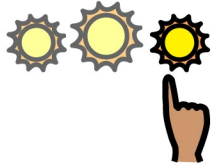
Then he said, "It is finished." Jesus bowed his head and died.



Jesus was buried in a tomb and they rolled a large stone in front of it.



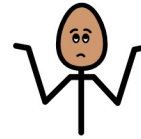
They also placed guards there to be sure no one could get in.

Mary stayed at the tomb and two angels were there where Jesus' body had been.



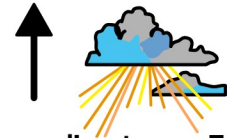
Then Mary saw a man who asked her, "Why are you crying?" She didn't know it was Jesus.
