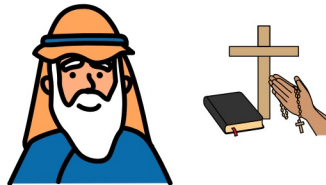
In the book of Hebrews,

Abraham had faith.



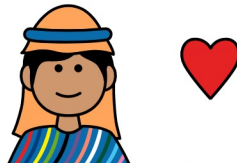
God spoke to him when  
he was 75 years old



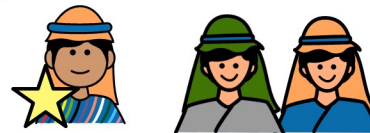
and told him to leave

dad and made sure



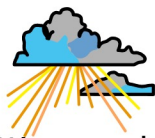
his brothers knew that

in a country far away.



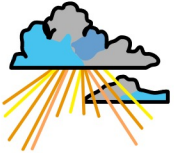
Instead of getting mad,

had no food.



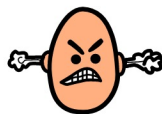
Now Moses. Moses was old

to.



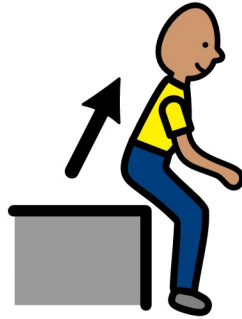
Trusting God does mean
