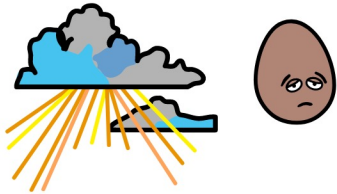
Jonathan and David were very different from one another.

David was a Shepherd and spent a lot of time alone.



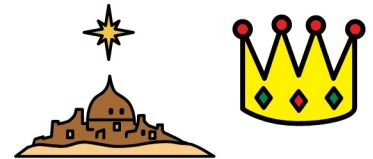
God was unhappy



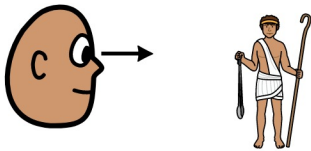
with King Saul.



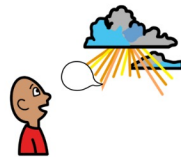
God sent the prophet Samuel



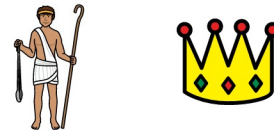
to Bethlehem to choose a new king.



When Samuel saw David,



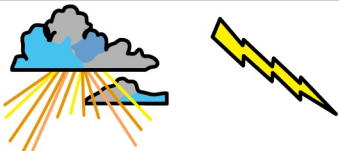
God spoke and told Samuel that

David went to the battle line to face a giant, Goliath.



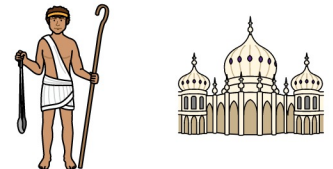
With God's power, David faced Goliath



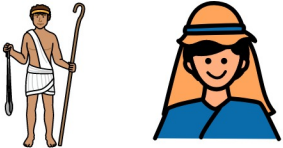
with a slingshot and 5 stones. Goliath was killed.



King Saul was happy and invited David



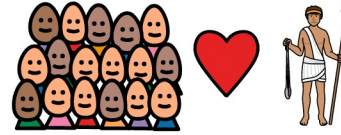
to live in the palace and lead his army.



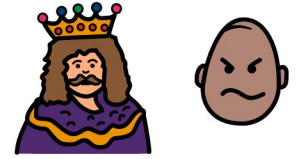
That is how David met Jonathan and they became best friends.



David led the army and did a great job!



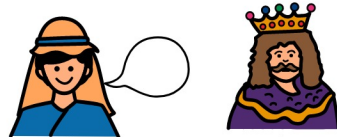
The people loved David



and King Saul was mad about that.



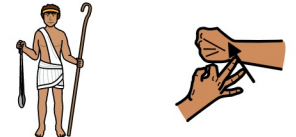
King Saul tried to kill David several times.



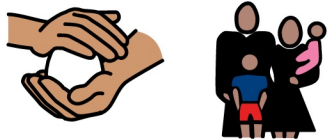
Jonathan protected David by speaking to his dad, King Saul.



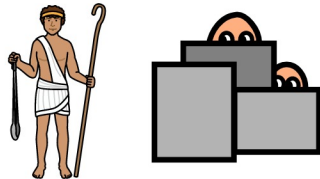
King Saul promised not to hurt David, but kept breaking that promise.



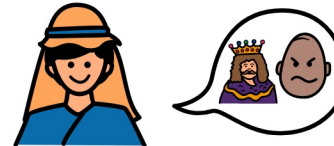
Jonathan and David made a plan that would keep David safe.



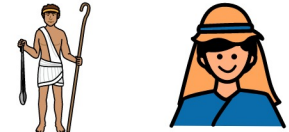
David promised to protect Jonathan's family when things got better.



Then, David went to hide.



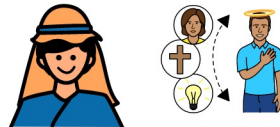
Jonathan gave David the message that King Saul was still very angry.



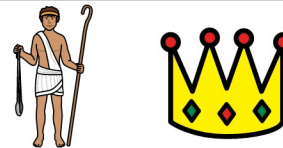
David had to leave, but he was still good friends with Jonathan.



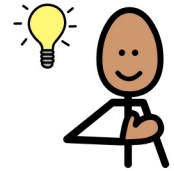
King Saul never stopped chasing David.



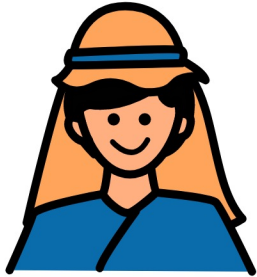

Being faithful means that we keep our promises.



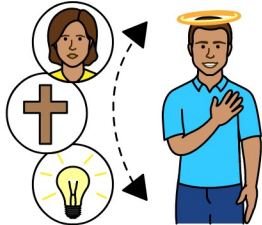

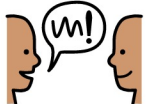
