Abraham and Sarah a son



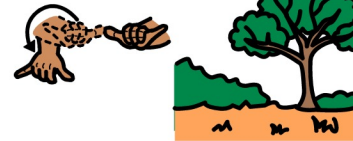
and they named him Isaac.



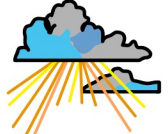
Isaac and his family lived in the land of the Philistines.

and I will be with you and will bless you..."



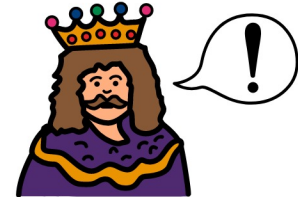
So Isaac stayed in the land and his people searched for water.



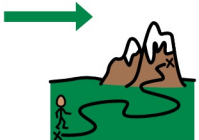
They found many wells.



The Philistines shoveled dirt into the wells so they wouldn't have water.



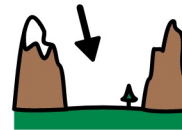
The King ordered



Isaac and his family to move away because he had too much power.



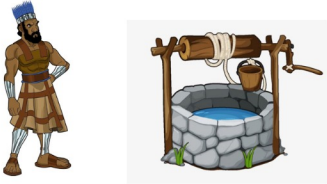
Instead of fighting back, Isaac chose to trust God

The nearby Philistines came and took over those wells.



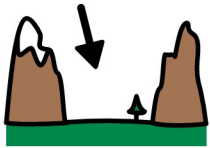
Instead of fighting over the wells, once again,

trusted God and



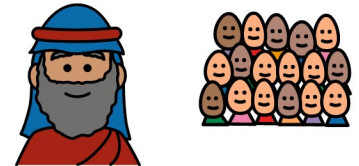
moved camp down the valley.



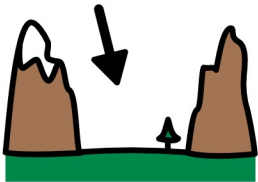
There, new wells of clean and clear water were dug up,



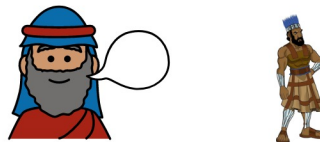
but the Philistines came and took over.



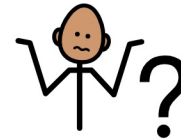
For a 3rd time, Isaac and his people

This time, Isaac was left in peace. He asked the Philistines,



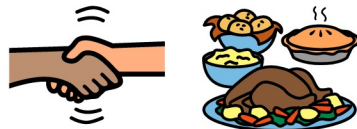
"Why have you come to me, since you were hostile to me and sent me away?"

kept trusting God no matter what!

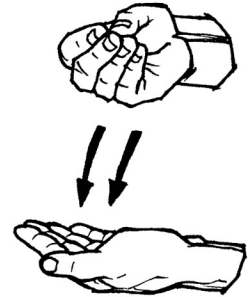
