obeyed God.



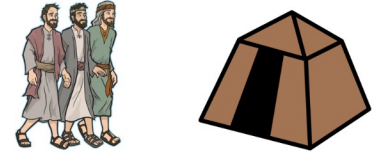
God had promised Abraham a

thought.



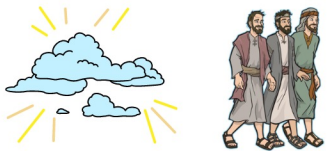
Abraham's trust in God

keeps His promises.



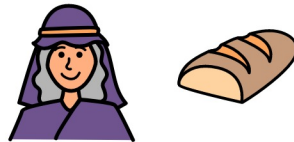
When Abraham was 99

up again.



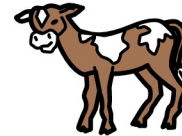
Three strangers appeared to

the shade of his tent.



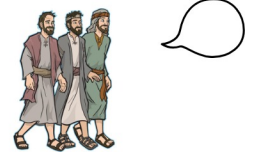
He knew they were from heaven.



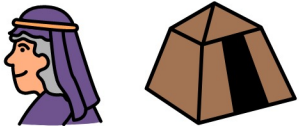
Abraham asked Sarah
to bake some bread



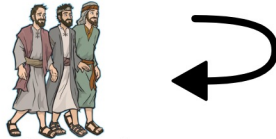
and a servant to prepare
the best calf for them.



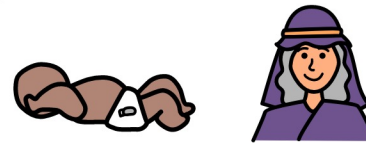
As they ate, the stranger said

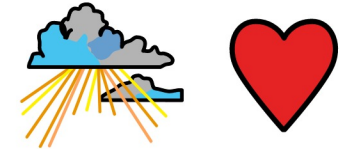
Sarah was afraid



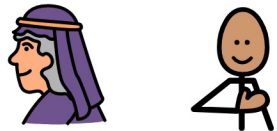
so she lied and said, "I did not laugh."

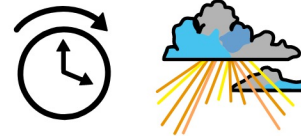
The Lord was gracious to Sarah as He had said,



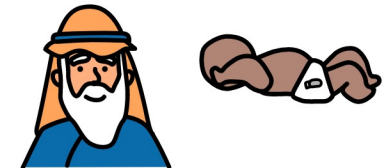
