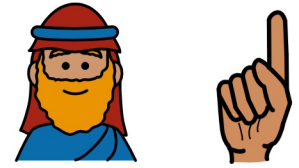
Genesis 28:10-22

They had twin boys named Jacob and Esau.



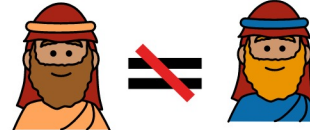
Esau was born first so he was given the birthright.

and would be able to lead the family when his dad died.



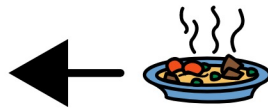
Jacob and Esau were very different and did not get along.



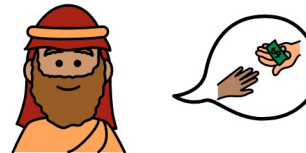
One day, Jacob was cooking some stew,



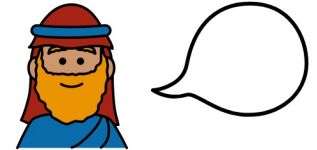
Esau came in from the open country, famished (hungry). He said to Jacob,



"Quick, let me have some of that stew! I'm famished!"



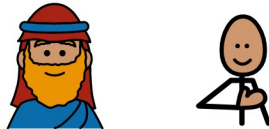
Jacob replied, "First, sell me your birthright."

So he swore an oath to him, selling his birthright to Jacob.

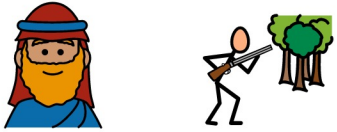


Many years later, when Isaac was very old and could no longer see,

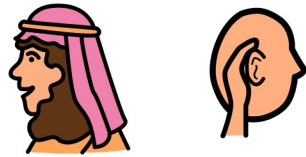


he wanted to pass along a blessing to his oldest Son - Esau.

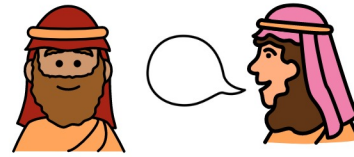

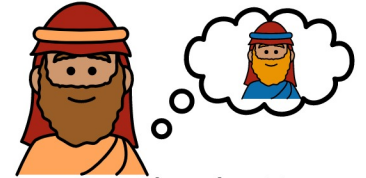
So Isaac sent Esau to go hunt and prepare a meal first.



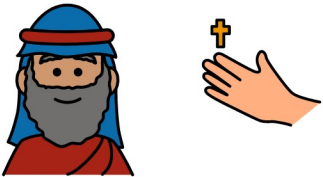
Rebekah overheard what Isaac had told Esau.

to pretend to be Esau so that he would get



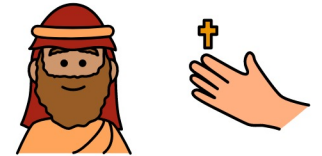
his father's blessing instead.



Jacob did what Rebekah told him.



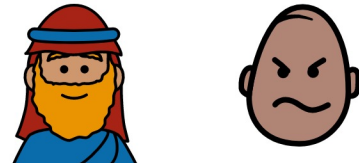
Sure enough, Isaac gave



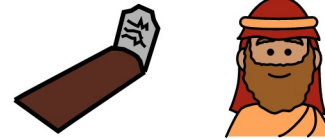
his blessing to Jacob, thinking that it was Esau.



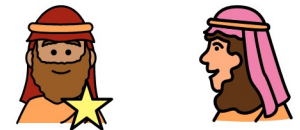
Isaac realized he was tricked.

Rebekah wanted to keep her favorite son safe, so she sent Jacob away to Haran.



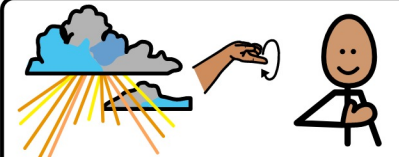
Jacob left home and curled up on the ground to sleep in the middle of nowhere.

he was still part of God's plan and God always keeps his promises!

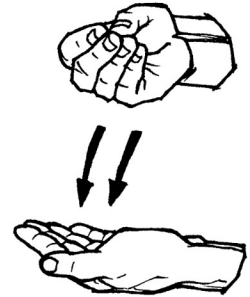
