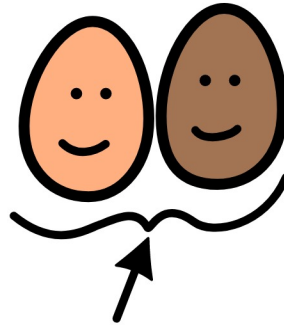

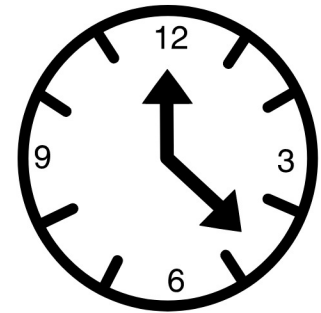

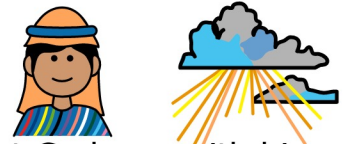
Genesis 41-45



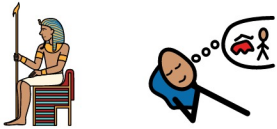
Last week we learned that Joseph was sold by his brothers

With God's help, Joseph interpreted Pharaoh's dream -



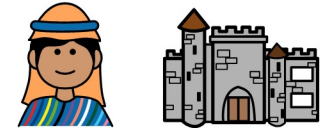
there would be 7 years of plenty of food



and 7 years of famine (not enough food).



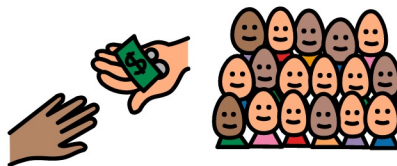
Joseph offered a plan to store up food during the good years so there would be enough to eat during the famine.

People would come to Joseph to buy food.



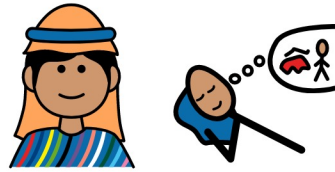
The famine spread far beyond Egypt to Canaan.



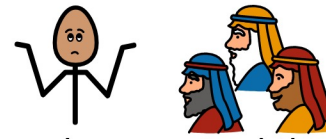
Jacob sent all of Joseph's brothers, except the youngest, Benjamin, to Egypt to buy some grain.

his younger brother.



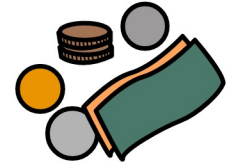
At first, Jacob refused to

they needed more food.



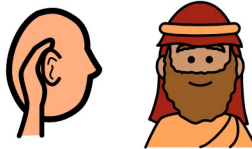
So Jacob allowed the

Benjamin along



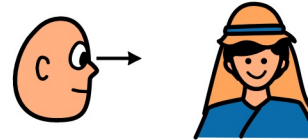
but with more money and  
gifts.



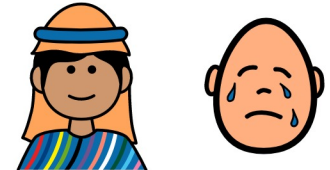
When they arrived in Egypt,

prepared.



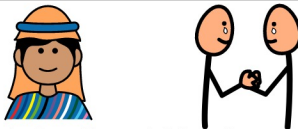
When he heard that his  
father was still alive



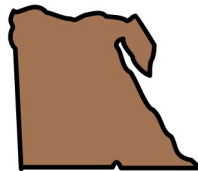
and saw his younger  
brother Benjamin,



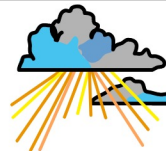
he left and wept.



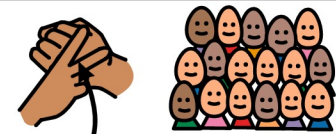
Joseph finally told his brothers

Abraham.

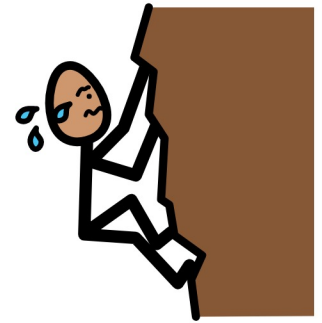
