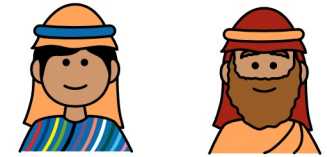
Exodus 2:1-10

charge of all of Egypt



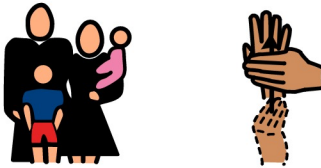
under Pharaoh and that he

(time with no food).



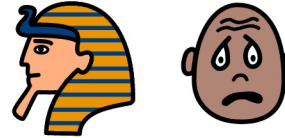
Joseph and his father,

reunited.



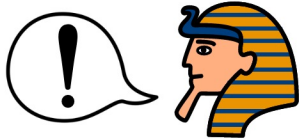
Joseph's family grew  
and the



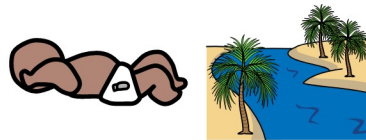
Egyptian Pharaoh got

slavery



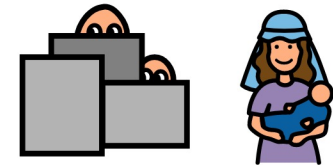

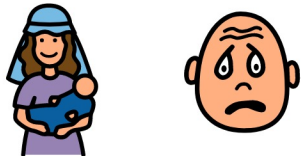

into the Nile River.



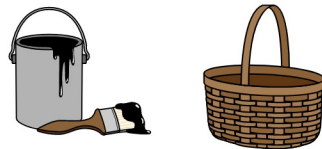
During this time, a man

tall grass in the Nile River.

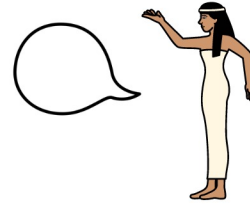


The baby's sister was  
watching.

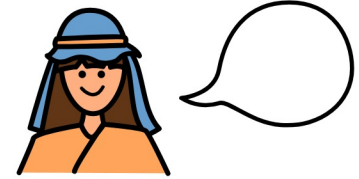
Pharaoh's daughter went down to the Nile River to take a bath.

"This is one of the Hebrew babies," she said.



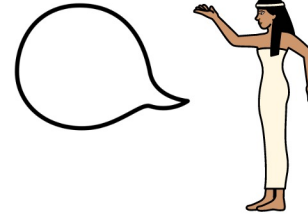
Then his sister spoke to Pharaoh's daughter and asked,



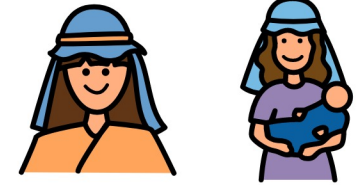
"Do you want me to go get one of the Hebrew women?"

"Yes, go," she answered.



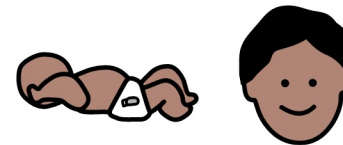
So the girl went and got the baby's mother.



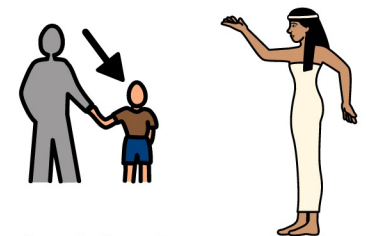
Pharaoh's daughter said to her, "take the baby and feed him for me. I'll pay you."

And he became her son. She named him Moses.

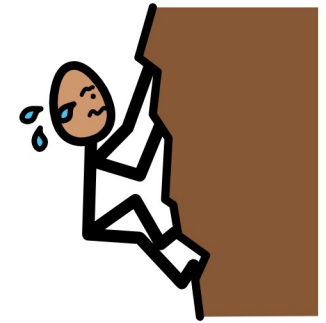
