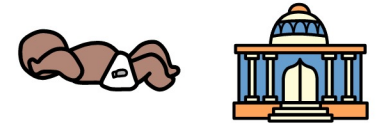
Exodus 3-6:12; 7-12

as they were enslaved in Egypt.



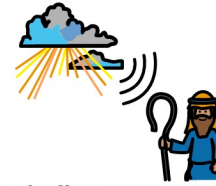
Moses was born and raised by Pharaoh's daughter in the palace.

I am the God of Isaac. And I am the God of Jacob."



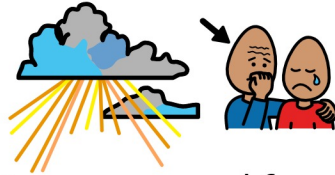
When Moses heard that, he turned his face away. He was afraid to look at God.



"I have seen how my people are suffering in Egypt."



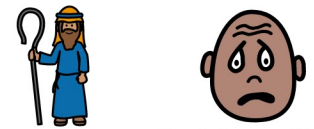
I have heard them cry out because of their slave drivers.

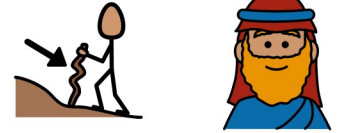
He told Pharaoh, "The Lord says let my people go...."



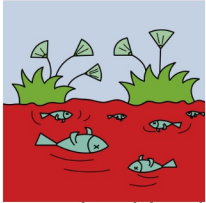
Instead of releasing the Israelites, Pharaoh made them work even harder.

and it turned to blood so no one could drink from it.



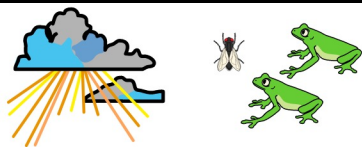
But still, Pharaoh wouldn't let the people go.



God called Moses to speak to Pharaoh again and again. Moses didn't give up!



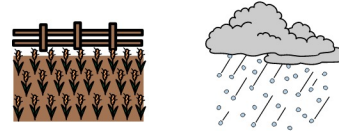
Pharaoh would promise to let the people go but didn't.



God sent frogs, followed by knats and flies,



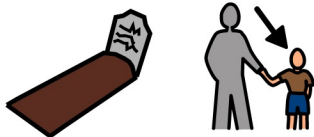
the cattle died, sores appeared on the Egyptians,

God's people were finally free.

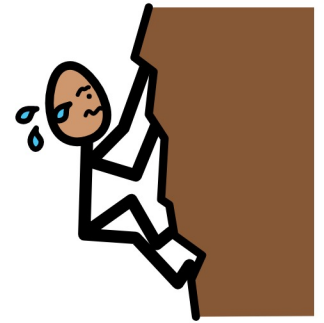
