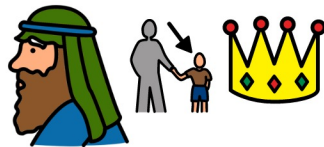
His story starts when
God sent Samuel



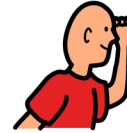

a new king.



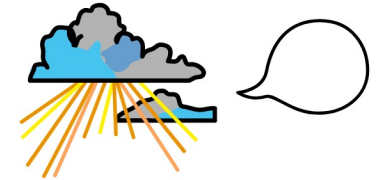
God told Samuel that he

a king.



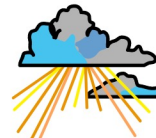
God said,

have not chosen him."



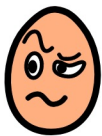
Jesse sent for his

Israel.



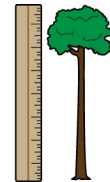
David wasn't king yet and

Philistine invasion.

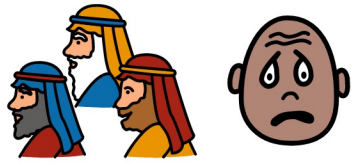


The Philistines had a
warrior named Goliath

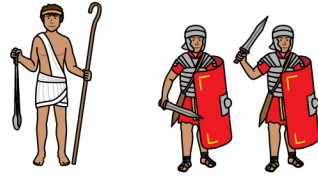


that was more than 9 feet

Jesse told David to go to where his brothers were to check on them.



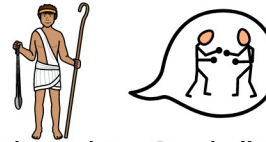
When he arrived David heard Goliath say, "Come and fight me, I dare you!"



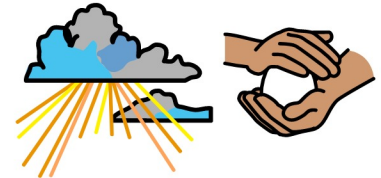
David said, "He's bringing shame on Israel and trash talking God!"



Saul sent for David as he heard that David was asking about Goliath.



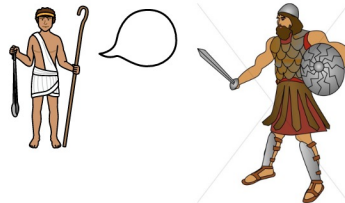
David said to Saul, "I'll go and fight him. I've killed a lion and a bear."



God will save me from this Philistine."



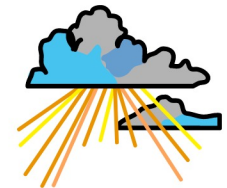
So David found 5 smooth stones from a stream.

Saul was so impressed with David that he invited him to live at the palace.

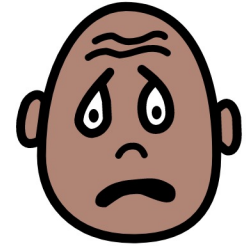
