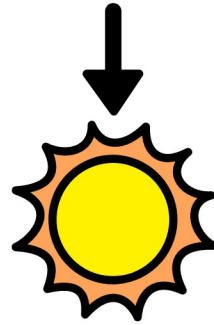


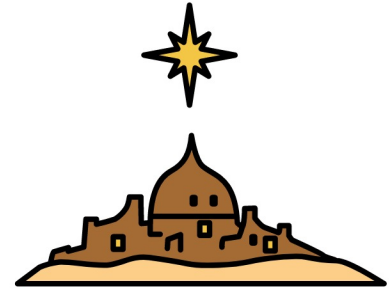

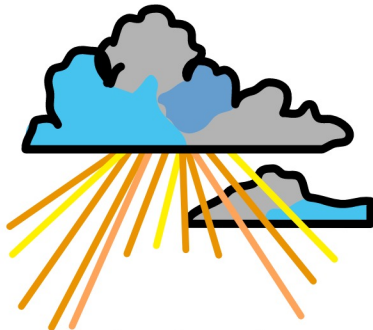

who was married to a man named Joseph.



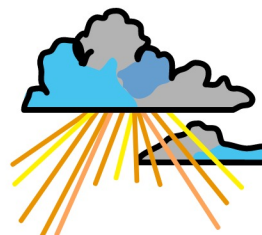
An angel appeared to Mary and told her



she would become pregnant and give birth to a son.



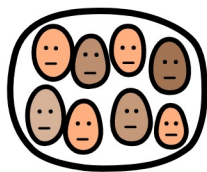
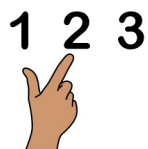
The baby would be called Jesus



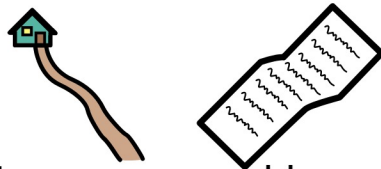
and he would be great and called the Son of the Most High God.



This was a time when the Roman ruler Caesar Augustus commanded a census.



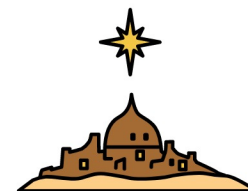
Everyone had to be counted and pay taxes.



Everyone would have to go to their own home town to be placed on a census



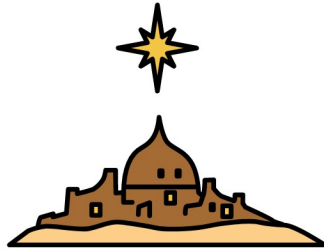
Mary and Joseph heard the news and would have to



make a week-long journey to Bethlehem.



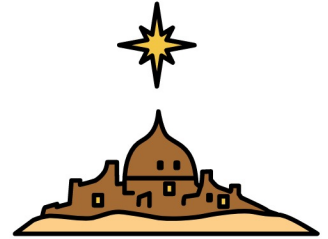
So Mary and Joseph traveled by donkey



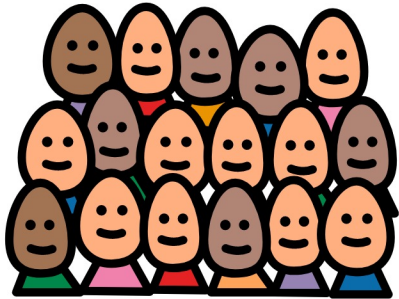
to the town of Bethlehem.
