Read John 20:1-23

As you read through John 20:1-23, think about all the emotions that everyone was likely experiencing as they began to realize that Jesus was alive. Draw emojis that match those feelings on a separate piece of paper. Then without looking at your Bible, use the emojis to retell the story to someone else.

In most cases, you were using clues from the story to make an educated guess about people's emotions, but in verse 20, John comes right out and says it: "The disciples were very happy when they saw the Lord." Jesus is alive, and that is a reason to celebrate!

## Day 4

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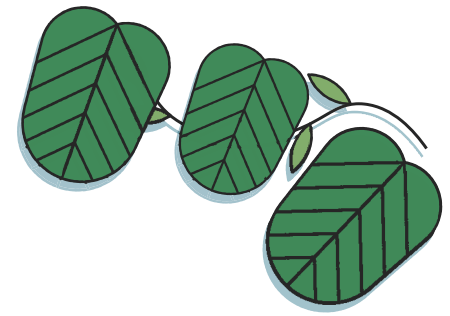
There are lots of ways to celebrate that Jesus is alive, and it can be fun to hear other people's traditions.
