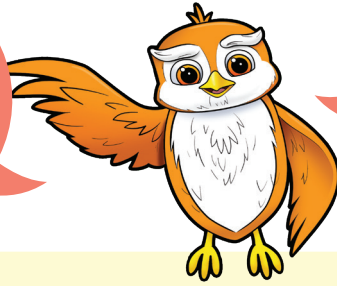

WEEK 1

WEEK 3

God creates all of the sea animals and birds on day five.

Genesis 1:20-23

What are some animals that live in the sea? (Octopus, whale, fish, etc.)
What color is your favorite bird?

WEEK 4

God creates land animals and people on day six, and then God rests on day seven.

Genesis 1:24-2:3

What land animal sounds can you make?
Who did God make in His image? (Me, people, everyone)
