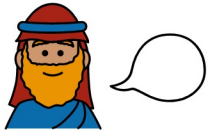
This week, we learn about a religious leader -



who thought he was pretty smart.



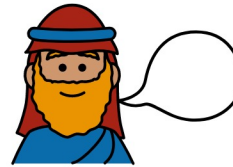
One day, he stood up to test Jesus.



"Teacher," he asked, "what must I do to inherit eternal life?"



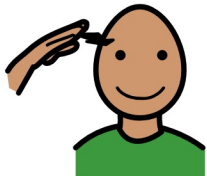
Jesus replied, "What is written in the law? How do you read it?"

"Love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your strength



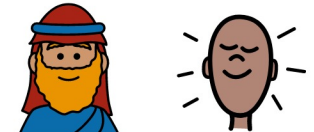
and with all your mind'; and



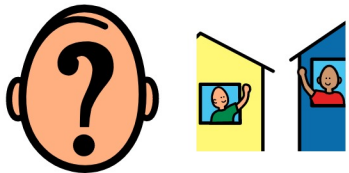
'love your neighbor as yourself."

But the religious leader wanted to make himself look good so he asked,



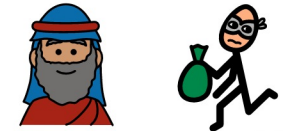
"Who is my neighbor?"

Suddenly, some robbers came and hurt the man. They took all that he had.

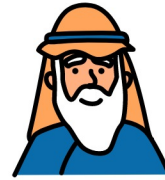

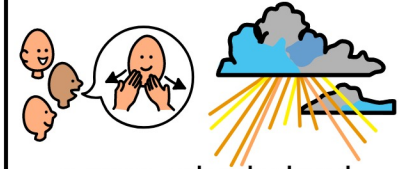
Later, a priest came along



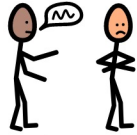
and pretended he didn't see the hurt man.



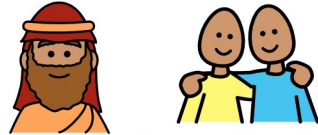
Then, a Levite came along. A Levite is



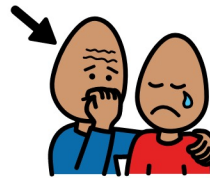
a man who helped people worship God.



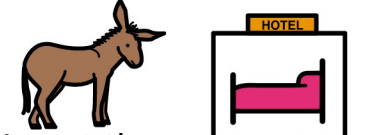
Just like the priest, he ignored the hurt man and walked on by.

He felt sorry for the man and stopped to help him.



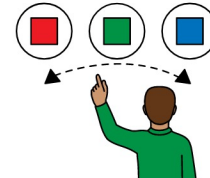
He put the man on his donkey and took him to an inn.



He even paid for the man to stay there.



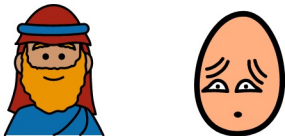
When Jesus was finished telling the story, he asked the religious leader,



"Which of the three people do you think was



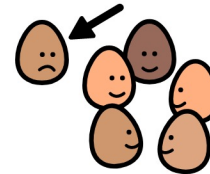
a neighbor to the hurt man?"



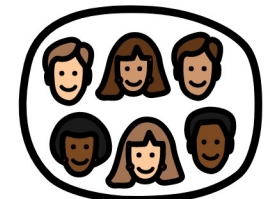
The religious leader was forced to humbly admit the answer. (The Samaritan)
