

WEEK 1

John 4:1-30

Matthew 9:9-12; Luke 5:1-11

Can everyone follow Jesus? (Yes) Who does Jesus want to follow Him? (Everyone)

WEEK 3

Jesus shows His friends, the disciples, how to be a good friend and washes their feet.

John 13:3-17

Why didn't Peter want Jesus to wash his feet? (Because he thought Jesus was too special to wash feet) Why did Jesus wash His friends' feet? (To show them how to be a good friend)

WEEK 4

People spread palm branches and coats on the road and cheer when they see Jesus coming.

Matthew 21:1-11,15-16

Who can celebrate Jesus? (Everyone) Cheer for Jesus and say, "Hosanna! Hosanna! Yay, Jesus!"


WEEK 5
