the Israelites the things that God said and did over the last 40 years.



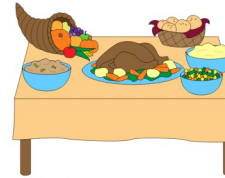

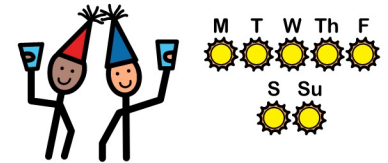

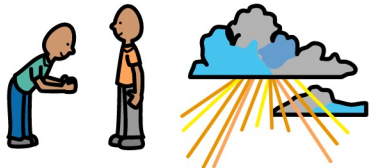

One celebration is called the Feasts of Booths.



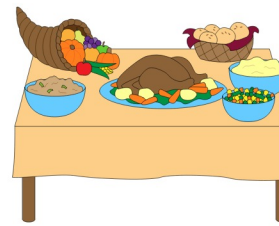
They celebrated this feast for 7 days



to honor God. We see in scripture how



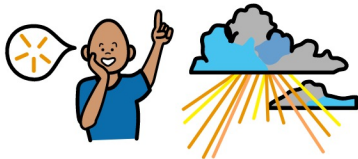
God's people celebrated this feast on several occasions throughout history.

The people made special shelters during the Feast of Booths.



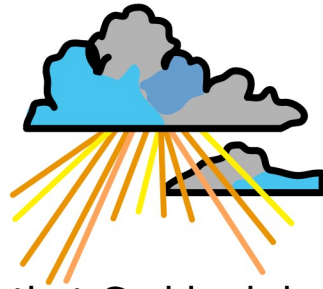
The people camped out in the booths and shared meals together while



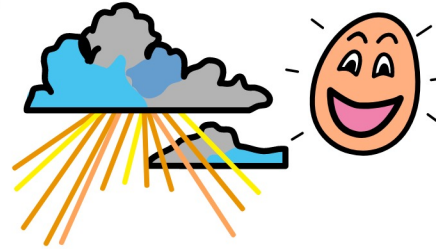

for them.



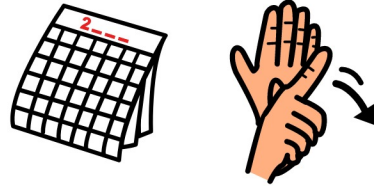
