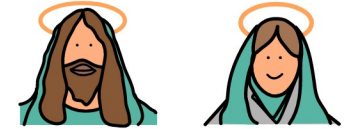
John 2:1-11 (NIRV)

Jesus replied, "Dear woman, why are you telling me about this?"



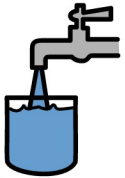
The time for me to show who I really am isn't here yet."

These jars could hold more than 20 gallons of water.



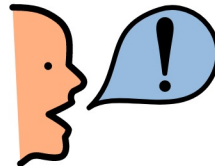
After the jars were filled, Jesus told the servants,

He drank from the cup and declared



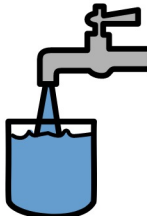
that the best wine was saved for last.

water into

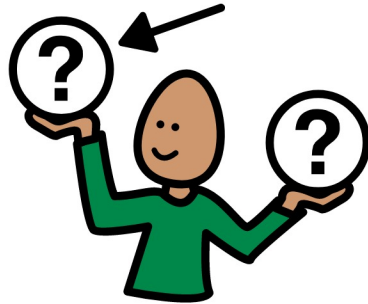


wine so that



family and friends could continue to celebrate together.

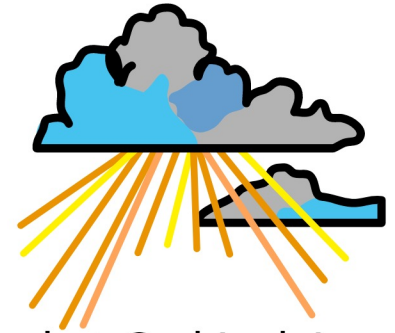
